The two-year Joint-Degree M.Sc. programme consists of four semesters, during which fifteen thematic modules and the Master Thesis have to be completed. Admission

Admission requirements:

- B.Sc either in science, agriculture, or engineering, or other related fields with above average result.
- provide proof of good command of the English language,
 equivalent to 550 points in paper-, or 213 points in the computer-based TOEFL, or 80 points in the internet-based TOEFL,
 or IELTS overall band of 6.0.

This can be exempt for applicants whose first languages are English and are resident in a country with English as official language or other English tests which are acceptable according to the regulation of both universities.
